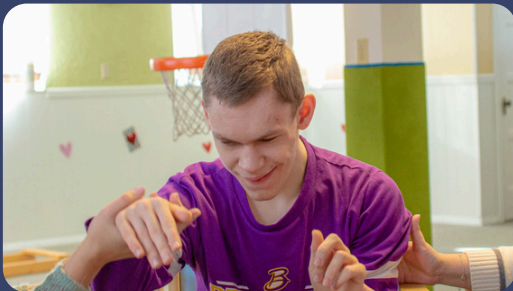

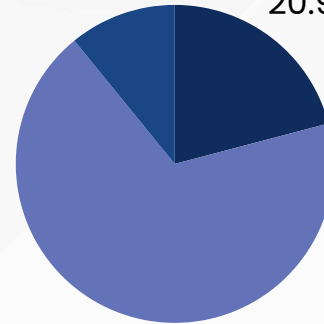

Nancy Lopez Golf Tournament 68.2%

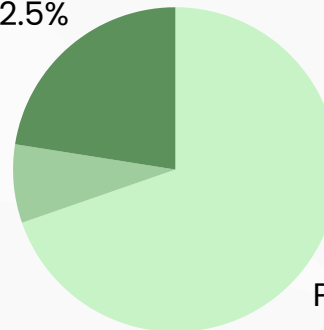
